

- Article 32. To see if the Town will vote to retain its alewife rights in 1982, and to have the Town collect 20% of all receipts from the alewives sold, said amount to be put into the general fund. ✓
- Article 33. To see if the town will vote to accept as Town Road two miles of the western section of Paul Bunyan Shores Road, starting at Route 195. (Article requested by Mrs. Roger Johnson.)
- Article 34. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to accept, on behalf of the Town, grants of private, state, or federal funds which they feel are in the Town's interest to accept. The Budget Committee recommends a YES vote.
- Article 35. To see if the Town will vote to accept the Cemetery Trust Fund of Carl Bryant in the amount of \$300.00. The Budget Committee recommends a YES vote.
- Article 36. To see if the Town will vote to delete Section 4 of the Gouldsboro Recreation Committee Ordinance which reads: "Vacancies will be appointed by the Selectmen to serve until the next town election." and insert: "Section 4. Two alternate members will be appointed by the Selectmen for a one year term. Vacancy of a regular position will be filled by an alternate, designated by the Selectmen until the next regular election."
- Article 37. To see if the Town will vote to enact the Gouldsboro Volunteer Fire Department Ordinance. (The Fire Department recommends a YES vote.)

VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT ORDINANCE
Town of Gouldsboro

1. **Establishment:** Pursuant to 30 M.R.S.A. Section 1917 the Town of Gouldsboro hereby establishes the Gouldsboro Volunteer Fire Department.
2. **Purpose:** The Volunteer Fire Department shall provide fire protection for the inhabitants of Gouldsboro.
3. **Organization:** The Volunteer Fire Department shall be organized and shall function under its own set of by-laws that are not in conflict with state law of this ordinance.

4. Fire Chief:

- a. **Appointment, term and compensation:** The Fire Chief and Deputy Fire Chief shall be appointed by the Board of Selectmen for one year. The compensation for the Fire Chief and Deputy Fire Chief shall be determined annually at town meeting.
- b. **Powers and Duties:** The Fire Chief shall have the powers and duties as stated in 30 M.R.S.A., Chapter 28, Section 3773.

5. Firefighters: A volunteer firefighter is an active member of the Volunteer Fire Department and receives no compensation from the Town other than injury and death benefits. A firefighter's duty is to extinguish all fires to which he is called, protect lives and property endangered by fires and carry out all other related activities as directed by the Fire Chief.

6. Liability:

- a. **Municipal:** The Town is liable for vehicular accidents and demolished buildings as stated in 30 M.R.S.A., Chapter 28, Section 3775.
- b. **Volunteer Fire Department and Firefighters:** All volunteer firefighters, under the direction and control of the Fire Chief and while actually engaged in firefighting operations, shall be considered agents of the town and shall have the same privileges and immunities as the town employees performing a governmental function.

7. Fire Aid to Other Towns: The Town of Gouldsboro shall maintain an active mutual fire fighting assistance agreement with Hancock County, the Naval Security Group Activity and Steuben.

- Article 38. To see if the Town will vote to enact the Gouldsboro Building Permit Ordinance. The Planning Board recommends a YES vote.

BUILDING PERMIT ORDINANCE
Town of Gouldsboro

PURPOSE

The ordinance is designed to aid the Board of Assessors in arriving at a more just and complete assessment of the property of the town, providing for permits and prescribing penalties for violations.

SCOPE

The provisions of this ordinance shall apply to all new constructions, alterations and additions of any building or part thereof wherein the cost of materials needed for completion equals or exceeds \$2,500.00. This ordinance also applies to the locating or relocating of mobile homes. This ordinance does not apply to the normal upkeep and maintenance of buildings.
