A Resolution by the Citizens of Gouldsboro, Maine: Protecting the Health and Integrity of the Local Food System

The residents of Gouldsboro, Maine, declare that they have the right to produce, process, sell, purchase, and consume foods grown locally; and further declare that family farms, sustainable agricultural practices, and food processing by individuals, families and non-corporate entities is essential to our rural way of life. Residents should have unimpeded access to locally grown food; and Gouldsboro farmers should enjoy the freedom to produce food for the consumption of local residents.

Therefore, be it resolved that the citizens of Gouldsboro support local agricultural production of foods, the consumers' right to purchase such foods, and the farmers' right to market such foods at local markets or roadside stands.
