SELECT BOARD / TOWN MANAGER- *Gull Cottage Update-* Since the 2022 fire, the Navy has worked to identify viable alternatives for Gull Cottage. Prior to making a final decision on the future disposition of the building, the Navy will initiate consultation with the Maine State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO) and other stakeholders as appropriate in accordance with section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA). At this time, the Navy is proposing to restore the exterior of the building, returning the landmark to its historic outward appearance and creating a watertight exterior envelope. The interior would remain stable, but unfinished, enabling flexibility for potential future uses. The Navy remains committed to keeping the Town and public informed as the process moves forward.

Space Force Update- The United States Space Force unit, 10th Space Operation Squadron (10 SOPS) has assumed responsibility for mission operations at Detachment A, Prospect Harbor, Maine. The Navy will provide Base Support and facilities management until the property fully transfers to the Space Force, presently expected to occur by October 1, 2024. The Navy continues to be the component responsible for the disposition of Gull Cottage; however, it is expected responsibility will shift to the Space Force once the parcel is transferred.

2024 Dog tags will be available October 16th. Per Maine State Law, all dogs 6 months and older must be licensed each year by December 31st. A \$25 late fee for each dog unregistered will start February 1st, 2024. Proof of current rabies vaccination must be presented at the time of licensing. \$6 for neutered/spayed dogs and \$11 for unaltered dogs. You can register online at <u>https://apps1.web.maine.gov/cgi-bin/online/dog_license/index.pl</u> or in person here at the office. There will be a Rabies clinic November 15, 2023 from 3PM – 6PM at the Gouldsboro Town Office, 59 Main Street, Prospect Harbor. Dr. Brandi Smith with Go Vet Go will be administering rabies vaccinations to dogs and cats for \$10! Gouldsboro residents will also be able to register your dogs at this time.

The first half of property taxes are due Octoer 31st. Keep in mind interest starts accruing November 1st. Please include a phone number with your payment so we can attach it to your account. You can now pay online at <u>https://epayment.informe.org/payportonline/disclaimer/1502</u>. If you're sending a check, please make sure it's payable to the Town of Gouldsboro. If you pay with a credit card over the phone, in the Town Office or online, there is a 2.5% charge fee for anything over \$40. This fee goes directly to the state.

We will be closed Wednesday, October 4th to allow our office staff to attend the Maine Municipal Convention for training purposes.

We would like to thank all of our members of our Fire, EMS, Emergency and Police Department for their excellent around the clock service to our community and residents before, during and after Hurricane Lee. GOULDSBORO FIRE DEPARTMENT- Fire prevention week falls the week of October 8th – October 14th. As we visit the Peninsula School every year to make the children aware of Fire Prevention, it gives us the opportunity to let the kids get comfortable with our gear and equipment. Fire personnel teach the kids how to stay low in case of a fire, practice EDITH (Exit Drills in the Home), emergency use of a cell phone, and more. The kids are also taught to not be afraid of First Responders when we show up to an emergency. We are committed to keeping you and your families safe!

Absentee ballots will be available starting Tuesday, October 10th, 2023. Closed period for new voters will begin Wednesday, October 18th, 2023 end of business day.
