Kevin Barbee, of Barbee Construction, discussed the Aqua Shell plans to demolish 3 sheds on plot 34 of their 4 lot property on Shore Road. The permit requested on behalf of Aqua Shell would be contingent upon approval by the DEP. Demolition debris will be removed to an approved landfill. Aqua Shell may want to put a way station there or otherwise use the site of the demolished sheds so they want to retain the right to use their footprint to rebuild. Kevin Barbee said that as the sheds are non-complaint structures, he believes that they will be able to do this. Chairman Ray Jones said that as it would be replacement within the existing footprint, in his

opinion it should be fine. The CEO said that he will seek clarification from the State,
