2026 SPECIAL TOWN MEETING WARRANT**

To: Brianna L. Mitchell, Resident, Town of Gouldsboro

Greetings:

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the voters of the Town of Gouldsboro in said County of Hancock, qualified by law to vote in Town affairs, to meet at the Gouldsboro Town Office, 59 Main Street, Prospect Harbor on Thursday the 12th day of March, A.D. 2026 at 5:00pm in the evening, then and there to act on Articles numbered 1, 2, 3, and 4.

Twenty-four (24) registered voters attended. Zero (0) non-registered voters attended.

ARTICLE 1. To choose a Moderator to preside at said meeting.

Motion by Bob Harmon to nominate Dwight Rodgers; 2nd by Johnathan Renwick. No other nominations were given. Nominations were closed. Three paper ballots were cast by registered voters to elect Dwight Rodgers as Moderator. Town Clerk Brianna Mitchell administered oath of office to Dwight Rodgers.

Motion to approve by Beth Guest; 2nd by Phil Tiffany. Passed as written.


